**PLEASE REMEMBER NO PARKING ON SCHOOL HILL ON THURSDAYS**

**SCHOOL HILL**

We have been made aware that parents/carers are STILL stopping and dropping off children on the zig-zag markings outside the school. Please don't stop on zig-zags lines, even for a very short time. Parking here blocks the view for pedestrians and approaching traffic.

Below are some reminders to keep School Hill safe:-

- a. Do not drop off children from your vehicle at the bottom of the school slope.
- b. Avoid parking on the corners at the top and bottom of School Hill.
- c. Do not park so that two cars are opposite each other, across the road, as this can easily cause a blockage if a larger vehicle uses School Hill.

**Please park with care and help make the area near and around our school a safer place for CHILDREN.**

For our new parents we would encourage you to take part in the 'NO PARKING ON SCHOOL HILL THURSDAY' initiative, where we ask parents either not to drive, if possible, on Thursdays, or to find alternative parking in the village. There are spaces within a short walk from the school, for instance Pond Green, Horsham Road and the High Street (but please avoid parking opposite the bus stop at The Gun Pub).

We would ask that parents pass on this information to grandparents and other child carers too.
