SPOTLIGHT ON SAFEGUARDING

'Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility, every day'

Safeguarding is what we do for all children and young people to keep them safe whilst in our care.

Child Protection describes the policies and procedures specifically for those young people who are at risk of serious harm or have been seriously harmed.

At St John the Baptist School, safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is everyone's responsibility. Everyone who comes in to contact with children and families within our community has a role to play. In order to fulfil this responsibility effectively, we consider, at all times, what is in the best interests of the child. All schools must appoint a member of staff from the senior leadership team to the role of designated safeguarding lead. Our senior member of staff appointed is Mrs Jane Sharrock.

What is a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)?

The DSLs take the lead responsibility for child protection. Key aspects of the 'Designated Safeguarding Lead' role includes:

- Being available
- Making sure all staff are aware how to raise safeguarding concerns
- Ensuring all staff understand the symptoms of child abuse and neglect
- Managing referrals to social care
- Working with children who are the subject of child protection plans
- Maintaining accurate and secure child protection records
- Raising awareness of the school's safeguarding policies and procedures, and ensuring they are implemented and reviewed regularly
- Accessing up-to-date training
- Providing support and training to staff
- Understanding the views of children
- Sharing information
