Welcome back to the start of a new academic year. The children have come back to school looking really smart, eager to see their classmates and teachers and ready to take on the learning for this new term.

We started the week with our Launch Assembly. Our Value this term is Respect. We discussed what this actually means and focused on kindness. The children and adults completed a small activity thinking about how they were going to show kindness this half term.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

School meals are free for all state school pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 of primary school. These are known as 'universal infant free school meals'.

However, if your family are living on a low income and claiming certain benefits, your child may be able to get a free lunch regardless of their school year (known as 'benefit-related free school meals'). If your child qualifies for benefit-related free school meals, you should apply for this as they will not **only qualify for a free hot meal**, **but other subsidies including a free school sweatshirt, polo shirt and free milk.** For more information and to see if you are eligible, please follow this link: <u>https://www.westsussex.gov.uk/education-children-and-families/schools-and-colleges/free-school-meals/</u>
