HISTORY  Create a photographic collage showing changes to Cissbury Ring – this may be presented in any way.	GEOGRAPHY / MATHS  Data: Population What was the population of Tudor Britain? Can you find the major cities at that time and their population?	ENGLISH  Research some facts about life in Tudor times. HISTORY  Henry VIII Top Trumps Make a set of Top Trumps showing the wives of Henry VIII. How long they were married to him? How old they were when they died? How did they die?
