As we are part of the Chichester Diocese, we work alongside the team who support us as a Church of England School. We had our termly visit this week and our new School Effectiveness Officer, Nick Sharp, had the opportunity to see our school, meet the staff and children and have a tour of our grounds. Feedback was very positive and he could see that we are a nurturing, family school.

Over the last twelve months, we have been reviewing the school vision and our mission – the reason we are here and what we do. This has now been finalised and updated on our website and appropriate policies. In Collective Worship, we looked at our new mission statement.

"Grown in Christ, Belong to Community and Serve with Purpose" and the children did a great job identifying who we are and what we do. There are some examples of what the children came up with:

What amazing answers they gave and how blessed we are that they could articulate this.

### **ATTENDANCE SPOTLIGHT**

Attendance Matters: Why Every Day Counts

Our current school attendance is 97.5% which is above national and a great start to the year.

I wanted to highlight the importance of school attendance.

- 1. Children who attend school regularly are far more likely to meet expected standards in reading, writing and maths. Missing a few days each month can lead to gaps in learning that are hard to catch up on.
- 2. Regular absences can affect a child's ability to secure friendships and feel part of the school community.
- 3. Children with less than 90% attendance have missed the equivalent of four weeks school.
- 4. Being in school builds positive routines and helps to reduce anxiety and isolation.



I also wanted to highlight that as of August 2024, the DFE mandate that:

- 10 or more unauthorised sessions (equivalent to 5 full school days) must trigger consideration of a penalty notice.
- A session is defined as either a morning or afternoon.
- Family holidays during term time are unauthorised absences.

As always, we are here to support all of our families and should you have any concerns or struggles with attendance, please do not hesitate to come and speak to me.
