



Song of Sounds

In Ash Class, and across KS1, we use a fun and lively phonics programme called Song of Sounds.

Children learn new sounds through songs, actions, stories and hands-on activities.

A catchy song, taught and sung daily, helps them remember all the Reception sounds with confidence. This playful and active approach supports children as they begin blending to read words and segmenting to help with writing.

How to Help at Home

- Sing the Song of Sounds with your child to help them remember the phonemes.
- Practise saying the pure sounds (e.g. 's' not 'suh').
- Play simple blending games such as 'Can you find the c-a-t?'.
- Encourage your child to spot familiar sounds in books, signs and labels.
- Read together every day, even for a few minutes.
- Celebrate effort and progress confidence makes a big difference.
