

Adding and Subtracting Numbers

LO: To recall and use addition and subtraction facts (11 - 15)

Complete the following calculations:

$6 + 7 = \underline{\quad}$	$\underline{\quad} + 4 = 11$	$\underline{\quad} - 7 = 7$
$7 + 5 = \underline{\quad}$	$\underline{\quad} + 6 = 14$	$\underline{\quad} - 3 = 8$
$6 + 5 = \underline{\quad}$	$\underline{\quad} + 5 = 12$	$\underline{\quad} - 6 = 6$
$8 + 7 = \underline{\quad}$	$\underline{\quad} + 8 = 13$	$\underline{\quad} - 4 = 9$
$5 + 9 = \underline{\quad}$	$\underline{\quad} + 9 = 15$	$\underline{\quad} - 6 = 9$
$15 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$	$5 + \underline{\quad} = 11$	$12 - \underline{\quad} = 4$
$13 - 4 = \underline{\quad}$	$5 + \underline{\quad} = 13$	$14 - \underline{\quad} = 7$
$11 - 7 = \underline{\quad}$	$7 + \underline{\quad} = 14$	$11 - \underline{\quad} = 6$
$12 - 6 = \underline{\quad}$	$5 + \underline{\quad} = 12$	$13 - \underline{\quad} = 5$
$14 - 7 = \underline{\quad}$	$6 + \underline{\quad} = 15$	$15 - \underline{\quad} = 8$

Challenge: How many pairs of one-digit numbers add to 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15? Can you use this to predict how many pairs will make 16, 17 and 18?

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Answers

$6 + 7 = 13$	$7 + 4 = 11$	$14 - 7 = 7$
$7 + 5 = 12$	$8 + 6 = 14$	$11 - 3 = 8$
$6 + 5 = 11$	$7 + 5 = 12$	$12 - 6 = 6$
$8 + 7 = 15$	$5 + 8 = 13$	$13 - 4 = 9$
$5 + 9 = 14$	$6 + 9 = 15$	$15 - 6 = 9$
$15 - 9 = 6$	$5 + 6 = 11$	$12 - 8 = 4$
$13 - 4 = 9$	$5 + 8 = 13$	$14 - 7 = 7$
$11 - 7 = 4$	$7 + 7 = 14$	$11 - 5 = 6$
$12 - 6 = 6$	$5 + 7 = 12$	$13 - 8 = 5$
$14 - 7 = 7$	$6 + 9 = 15$	$15 - 7 = 8$
