Maths	Using any numbers you like, use +, - x and ÷ to practise your number operations. You could use a dice, playing cards, computer generated number program or just choose numbers yourself for these calculations. See the school website for help on written calculation methods - (https://www.stjbps.co.uk/childrens-zone/learning-resources.html) Use a calculator to mark your work.
Maths	Learn the number facts and multiplication tables related to your Maths Planet Challenge using a method that works for you or any computer program.
Spellings	Learn to spell all the words from the spellings on the school website for your year group (https://www.stjbps.co.uk/childrens-zone/learning-resources.html) or from your weekly spelling sheet
Writing	Write a descriptive text of your choice. Don't forget to plan it, draft it and then edit it to make it the very best you can. Now highlight all the verbs in red, the adjectives in blue, the adverbs in green. Which ones do you have fewer of? Can you now add them in? Now highlight all of your sentence starters. What do you notice? Can you start each sentence with a verb or an adverb (How, when and where something has been done) Now write this up neatly using your best joined up handwriting
Topic	Research information about your topic this term and produce a fact sheet
Reading	Read daily and record your response to what you have read in your reading record book
History	Interview your parents or grandparents about what your school was like for them. Write it up in an interview script
Art	Create a 'still life' using three objects. Sketch it or paint it using shadow in your work.
